

SUBSIDIES AND HONORARIA

Student Member Subsidy

The MNSOTA board has passed a resolution to make our teacher training events *free* to student members. Currently those events are the All-State Teachers Workshop and the Fall Clinic.

In order to encourage new student members, MNSOTA will pay 50% of the first year student dues for new members. Students should send to the MNSOTA membership coordinator (Cindy Johnson, 516 West Lake St., Winona, MN 55987): their completed ASTA application form, a copy of their student ID, and a check for half the dues made out to ASTA. The MNSOTA membership coordinator will send the applications with payment for the full amount to the national office.

Student and Teacher Honoraria

MNSOTA gives financial support to students and teachers who attend national ASTA events. No receipts are required by MNSOTA for these Honoraria; for tax purposes, recipients should consider this as income. Support must be requested in writing to the MNSOTA treasurer by June 15 of the fiscal year of the national event.

Students who are selected to participate in the National ASTA Honors Orchestra are eligible for a \$150 award. Members who are selected to make a presentation at the National ASTA Conference, and who are not otherwise compensated for their presentation, are eligible for a \$150 award.
